

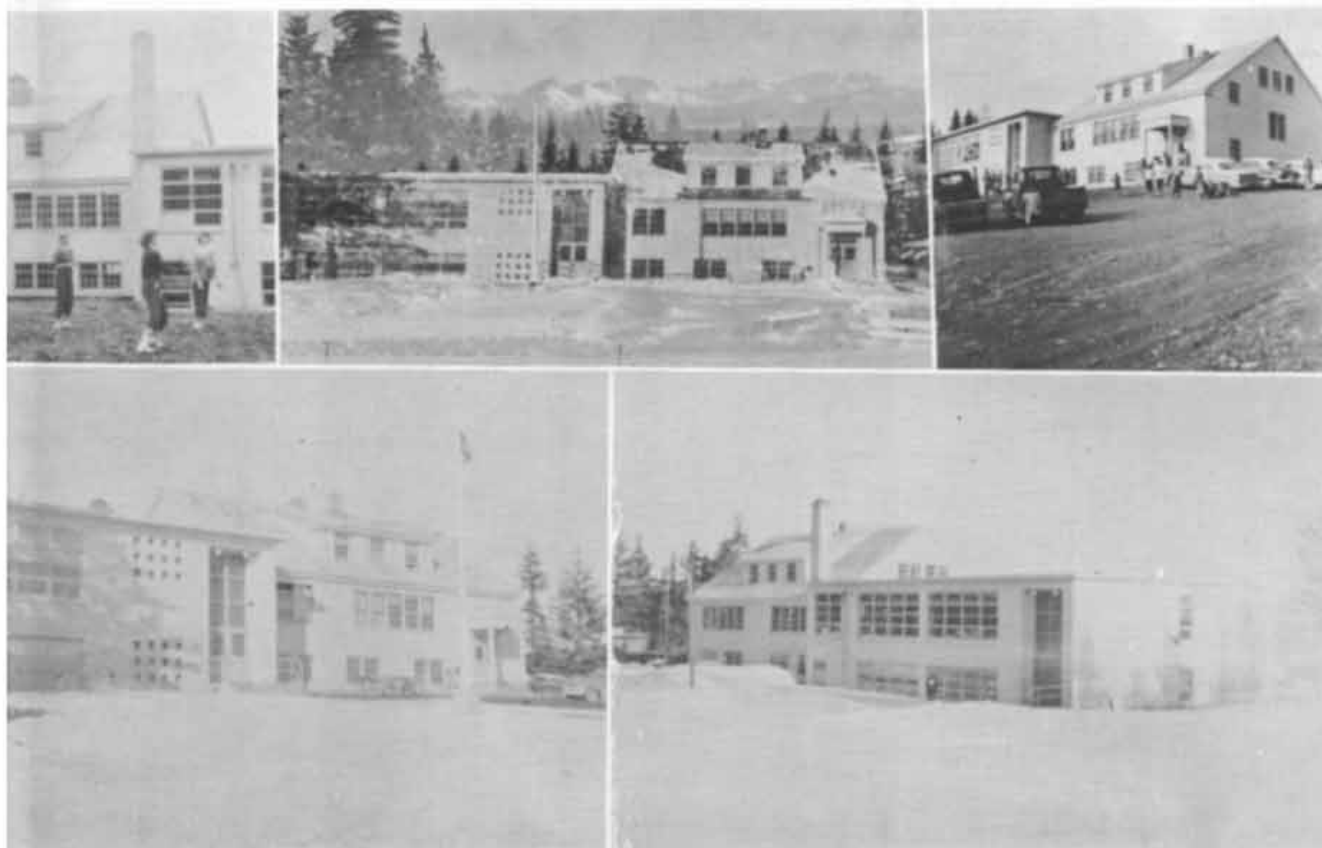
Mariners Log
